

PROCEEDS TO KENTUCKY HARVEST

Founded in 1987, Kentucky Harvest has as its mission to “get food from people who have it, but don’t need it to those that need it, but don’t have it—free of charge.” While simply stated, this mission is executed every day by a system that is anything but simple. An expansive network of volunteers picks up food that would otherwise “go to waste” from restaurants, bakeries, hospitals, food purveyors, stores, food goods manufacturers, schools, families and individuals. This food is then delivered to the needy at homeless shelters and food pantries around the region. Through the generosity of donors and the hard work of hundreds of volunteers, last year over 2 million pounds of food were placed in needy hands.
