WAIVER

I, or my parent or legal guardian if I am under age 18, agree, warrant, and covenant as follows: I know that running, walking or participating in a road race is a potentially hazardous activity. I, or my child, should not enter and race without being medically able and properly trained. I assume all risks associated with participating, or allowing my child to participate, in this event. If I am under eighteen years of age, consent of parent or legal guardian will be given and the parent or legal guardian agrees to all above legally bound statements. By signing and submitting the waiver, I, or my parent or legal guardian if I am under age 18, understand and agree to the terms of the waiver. NOTE: Before participating in the Race to End Homelessness 5K race/walk, all participants must sign a WAIVER.

After that weekend, late and day of race registration will be \$30. Participants under 18 years of age may register anytime at the discounted rate of only \$15. Race day registration at the event site opens at 8 am.

Park & Shuttle
